


End of Season Reminder

OVERVIEW OF NEXT WEEK'S LEARNING

Ms. Stanton Head of Year 1

In 1A the children are investigating the differences in dinosaur body parts and the impact this has on their characteristics. They are working as dinosaur dentists to investigate their teeth, as well as looking at their skeletons. In 1B the children are creating a variety of dinosaur inspired art including fossils and silhouettes, exploring different species through their structures.

In 1C the children are investigating dinosaur habitats. They are designing and creating their own versions of dinosaur habitats based on their investigations, considering what they needed to survive. In 1D the children are exploring the fascinating world of fossils. They will investigate how they are formed and how they help us understand life from millions of years ago.

In 1E the children are discovering what dinosaurs needed to survive and how we can classify them in different ways. They are investigating how differences helped them live in the prehistoric world.
