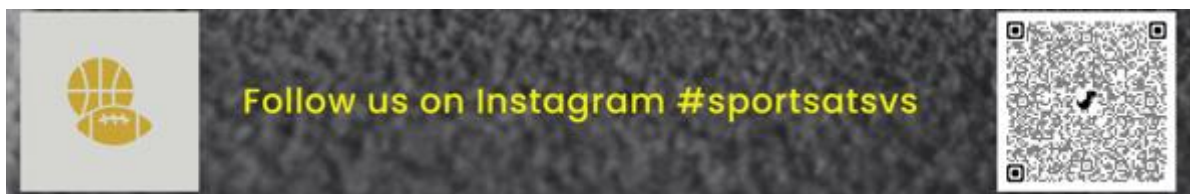

## PASTORAL UPDATES – HEALTH AND HYGIENE

As we are now fully in the Dubai winter season, temperatures are much cooler and students are playing together outside much more regularly. However, this more regular play outside means that all the students are in much more physical contact or proximity to each other. Unfortunately, this can lead to the risk of viruses, germs, coughs, and colds being spread more easily. Whilst we want our students to be in school as regularly as possible, we also want all our students to be healthy.

Below are some of the key indicators as to when you should keep your children at home and not send them to school:

- Fever ( $\geq 37.5^{\circ}\text{C}$ )
- Unexplained skin rash that has not been assessed by a doctor.
- Vomiting (return to school 24 hours after last episode of vomiting)
- Diarrhoea (return to school 24 hours after last episode of diarrhoea)
- Heavy nasal discharge/ runny nose
- Persistent cough
- Head lice/nits

When students do return to school after an illness and parents do not want to risk them becoming sick again, it may be advisable for them to wear a medical mask to prevent reinfection. If your child returns to school after a period of illness and you do not wish them to participate in PE or Swimming, we will also recommend that they do not participate in outdoor break when there is a greater risk of contact from many students.

We would encourage all families to educate their children about the benefits of covering their mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing. Similarly, all students should get into the habit of washing or sanitizing their hands after using the bathroom and before eating. Children should also wash or sanitize their hands after covering their mouth or nose following sneezing or coughing.

Whilst we would love to have all students achieving 100% attendance rates, we would not want this to happen whilst risking students' or staff's health and wellbeing.

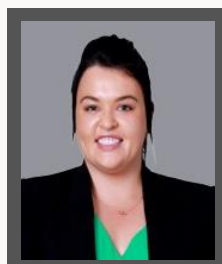

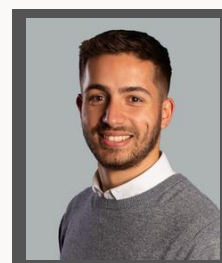
