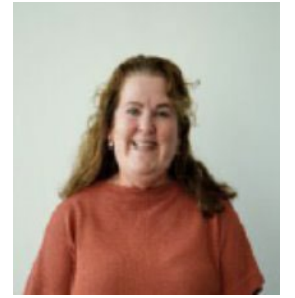




## Secondary School Weekly Friday 30th May 2025
