# **Road Safety Awareness**

For the week beginning Monday 17th November, South View School, will be marking Road Safety week in school. As a community school located in a busy residential area, we are pleased that so many of our students and families walk, scoot and cycle to school. However, it is important that all of our students and families are informed of the best way to be safe when they are on the pavements and when they are on the roads.

In 2024, there were 184 road fatalities in Dubai. Whilst there has been a significant decrease in the number of fatalities over the last 18 years, it is important that we educate students and families about how to stay safe as a driver, passenger, cyclist or pedestrian.

Our students from FS to Year 6 will be learning how to be safe in cars, how to keep themselves safe when cycling and the importance of having safe cars.

This is an appropriate moment to remind all of our families of the importance of : driving safely around the Remraam community; having your children in car seats and sitting with seatbelts; and taking care when approaching school. Please also remember that children under 16 years old are prohibited from riding e-scooters unaccompanied, according to RTA regulations. Therefore, no Primary students will be permitted to enter school with an e-scooter.


