
Katie Heather EYFS Inclusion Teacher




Miss Ruse's Highlight of the Week

Year 1 had their first trips to the Primary School Library this week and were able to pick books to bring home! They can keep these for a week and return them on their library days (as noted above) the following week.



PE and Swimming

We hope that you all had a great summer break and are ready for the new academic year!

The PE department is very excited about the year ahead with improved sport facilities and the swimming program back as normal.

- Students have 1 swimming lesson and 1 PE lesson per week.
- May I please introduce two new members of staff joining our team: Mr. Sheehan and Mr. Sanderson. I'm confident that they will be a valuable asset to our department.
- From Monday, 5th of September, swimming and PE lessons will start for students from FS2 to Y6. FS1 will start swimming after half term. Please view your Year Group page for swimming and PE days and send your child to school with correct equipment:
- PE: Full PE kit, sport trainer shoes, hair properly tight, no jewellery or makeup should be worn and water bottle.
- Swimming: 1 piece swimsuit or jammer, swimming cap, towel, flip-flops and swimming goggles. Muslim friendly swimming wear is allowed as long as it stays fit to the body and respects SVS uniform policy. Students are expected to bring their swimming kit underneath their school uniform to increase their time in the water. At the end of each swimming lesson, students should take a shower and change to dry clothes.
