Attendance

Attendance and achievement go hand in hand. Pupil absences have a negative effect on achievement. Empirical studies have found that each day of absence results in 0.3-0.4% of a standard deviation *decline* in achievement, though some studies have found even larger negative effects. This means that eight days of absence would move your child one place down a ranking of 100 pupils and sixteen days of absence would have approximately twice the effect. Please note the number of days absent your child has been this term. What effect do you think that has that had on their progress?

From next term, we will be rewarding the class with the highest
attendance with a Home Clothes Day on the last Friday of every month starting on the 27.1.23.



PE and Swimming

Dear Parents

This was a fantastic term in PE and swimming at South View School.

In PE we have:

- EYFS Developed their balance, coordination, agility, speed and ball manipulation ("me and the ball").
- KS1 Developed their fundamental movements and started to apply it into different game situation. During the "Hand & Feet coordination" topic they increased their control over a ball (pass, catch, dribble, bounce, throw and shoot) and started to apply these into small sided games.
- KS2 Netball, Football & Tag Rugby were the 3 topics developed. A
 recap on the essential skills needed, such as dribbling, passing and
 keeping possession. They have improved their understanding of both
 attacking and defending principles and working as a team.
