

### **SVS Bike competition**

Half of key stage 3 students have already had a session with Jon from cycle world to inspire them to design an SVS bike. The other half of key stage 3 students will meet Jon in the first week of the new term. All students in secondary are eligible to enter the competition. #### ICT

The Sandooq Al Watan iOS Design Challenge has started, and a few students have volunteered to take on this challenge. The aim is to design an iOS app focused on promoting one of the key tolerances of the UAE: Resilience, Compassion, Teamwork, and Dialogue. Students are tasked with designing an app prototype and then presenting it to a board of judges where the top 200 applicants will win a full scholarship for the Swift coding Accelerator program. Students have received their workbooks and will be working on it during the winter break and term 2A.

Additionally, there has been a coding club running on Tuesdays in which we explored the basic concepts of python coding. Students have learned about variables, basic arithmetic, operators, conditionals, and basic loops. We will continue to explore these concepts and will start applying them to solve real life problems.
